Air Corsica was set up by the Corsican regional authorities in January 1989 to improve air services to Corsica.

It has a fourfold objective :

- Offer Corsica control over its air transport resources in order to establish a high-quality public service,
- Increase the frequency and reliability of on-board services by choosing a fleet that is particularly well suited to the service,
- Expand its network in France and Europe,
- Contribute to the economic and social development of the island.

With more than two million passengers carried in 2023 to and from the island's four airports : Ajaccio, Bastia, Figari and Calvi, Air Corsica is the leading carrier in Corsica, with a very strong presence in winter, handling 88% of air passenger traffic in winter.



Fleet

Since its first flight in June 1990, Air Corsica has been committed to offering its customers a high-quality service. Its creation has made it possible to increase the frequency of rotations, reduce fares and create a real air bridge between Corsica and the main country. To increase the number of seats offered, the company has equipped itself with a fleet that is particularly well adapted to its network and regularly modernised.
